

Tyberg in concert

Next up will be a Buffalo performance at 7:30 p.m. March 1 in Temple Beth Zion, 805 Delaware Ave., by the prominent young pianist Katya Grineva, who will

play Tyberg's Piano Sonata No. 1, completed in 1920, and the 1934 Piano Sonata No. 2. Grineva will also record both of the sonatas for future release.

Grineva is an artist with a strong reputation as a pianist of exceptional romantic/poetic expression who above all values the beauty of tone. Her strong advocacy of the Tyberg sonatas indicates that she feels his music is a natural match for the interpretive pianistic principles she espouses.

A regular performer at New York's Carnegie Hall, Grineva

has singled out Tyberg's Sonata No. 1 for inclusion in her June 1 recital on that famed venue's main stage. That will be the first step in taking Tyberg's music to a wider, international audience.
