Russian pianist extraordinaire Katya Grineva will perform the world premieres of piano *Sonata No. 1* in B minor and *Sonata No. 2* in F# minor by Viennese Romantic composer Marcel Tyberg.

Marcel Tyberg, a brilliant young musician, tragically lost his life in 1944 during the Holocaust, but his original scores were saved by friends. They are only just now coming to public attention through the efforts of Maestro JoAnn Falletta and her collaborators.

All proceeds from this concert will benefit the **Tyberg Musical Legacy Fund** at the Foundation for Jewish Philanthropies.

Katya Grineva will also perform Tyberg's *Sonata No. 1* during her Concert at Carnegie Hall on June 1, 2006. She is recording the Tyberg Sonatas for the release of an upcoming CD.
